Crime Prevention

So in the last week we located 2 stolen motorbikes, one being located within an hour of being reported stolen. The simple method which helped find the motorbike was, the owner had placed a small tracking device within the bike and he was able to track the movement on an app within his smart phone. The location was pretty accurate too.

These devices are priced between £20-30 and are most certainly a great investment. They can be used on a variety of valuable items such as handbags, pushbikes, purses, toolboxes and vehicles.

On Friday 24th February we carried out Operation Safedrive in Langley Mill looking out for Traffic offences such as not wearing seatbelts, using mobile phones whilst driving and various other offences.

69 vehicles were pulled in for examination

38 tickets issued and 1 vehicle seized for not being roadworthy upon examination

Of the 38 tickets issued =

13 for not wearing a seatbelt

13 for use of a mobile phone whilst driving

2 for illegal window tints sports

7 for number plate offences

1 for tyre defects

1 for no valid MOT

1 for the illegal exhaust
