Why? Because it is...

EASY

- EASY** To forget to lock your car and close the windows
- EASY** To assume that because it is parked on your drive or outside your home that it is somehow safer
- EASY** To leave your valuable possessions highly visible
- EASY** To forget to register or securely mark mobile phones, laptops, tablets and kid's games that you leave on the back seat

- EASY** To forget to take your sat nav out of the vehicle and remove the holder from the windscreen
- EASY** For insurance companies to refuse to pay out when the vehicle was unlocked, leaving you to foot the bill
- EASY** For thieves, as stealing from an unlocked vehicle means that they are less likely to be seen and so more likely get away with it
