Rural Updates

The Long Eaton Safer Neighbourhood Team have been extremely busy keeping your streets safe, here are a few of the incidents we would like to share with you.

A joint police and fire investigation is underway at The Wilmot Arms, Borrowash. Several witnesses have been spoken to and a boy has been arrested in connection with the incident. Enquiries are ongoing at this stage.

PC LIMB has been out with the local Breaston Speed watch team, providing a visual presence and targeting speeding motorists. Road safety is a priority for the Long Eaton SNT team. A crime will be recorded against anyone who is abusive towards the Erewash Speed watch volunteers. 2 local residents have been visited.

There has been an increase in anti-social behaviour / damage at the BMX track / park, off Hopwell Road in Draycott. We are currently increasing our patrols in the area and will be dealing with any issues or offences we come across.

Following complaints of dangerous parking outside local schools, PC LIMB has completed patrols and will continue to do so.

Following a long investigation Jason HILL from Risley attended Derby Magistrates Ct in March 2023 and was found guilty of possession of Class A and Class B drugs with intent to supply.

- Youth related crime and anti-social behaviour in public places
- Working with partner agencies to support vulnerable people in the community at risk of criminality
- Road safety enforcement and education
